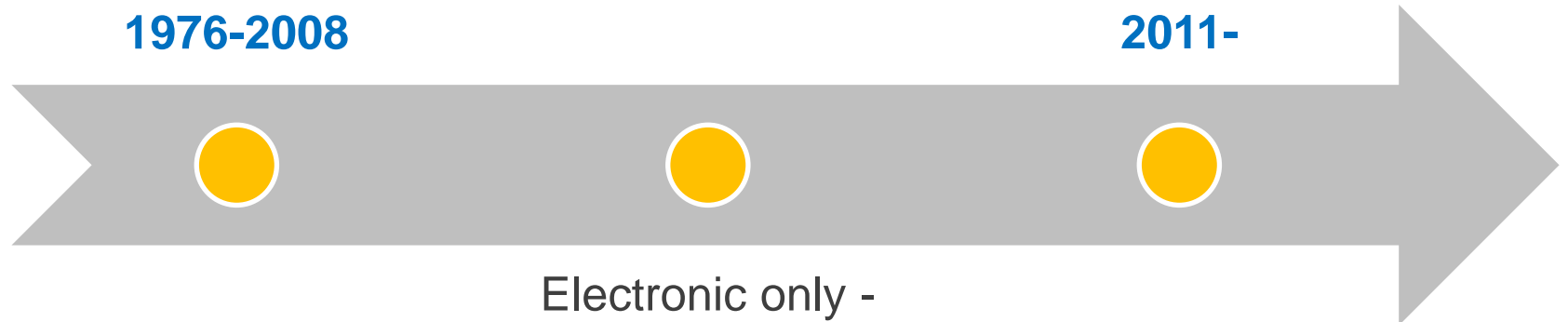

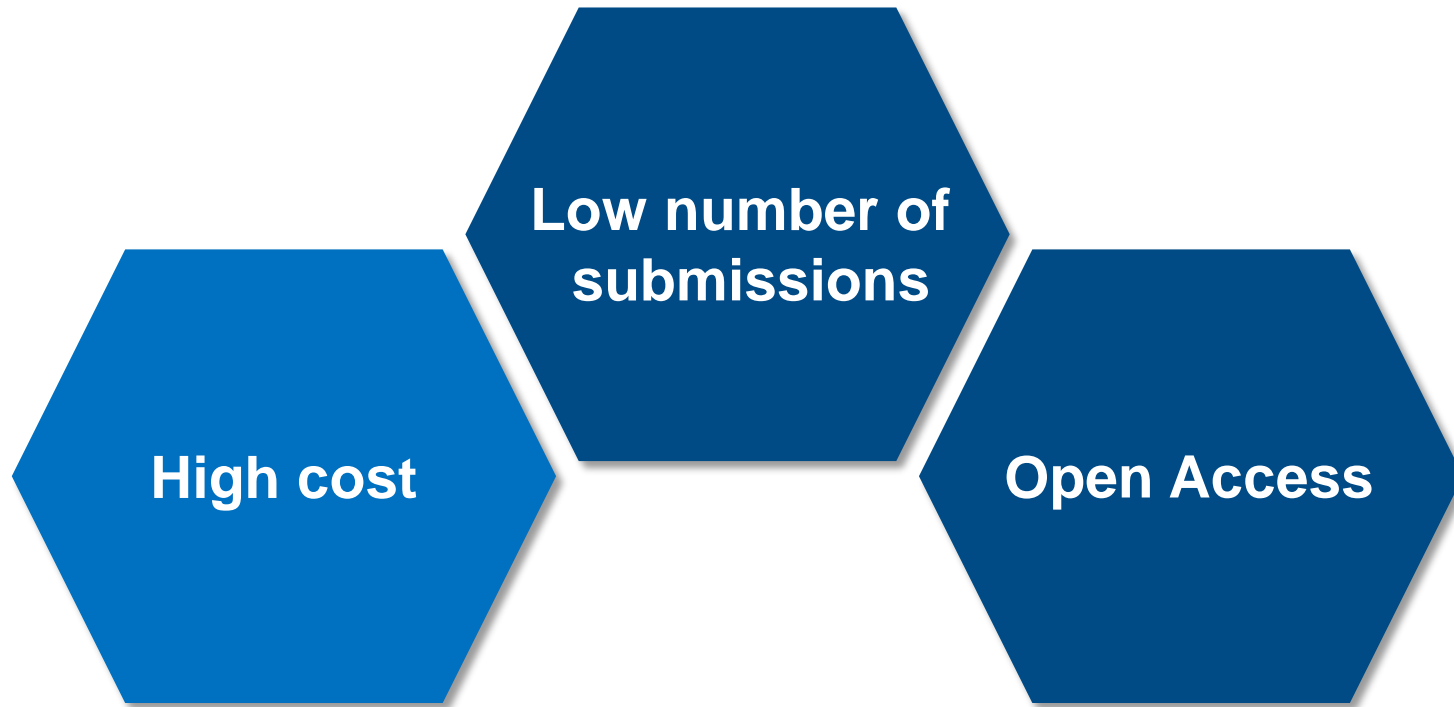

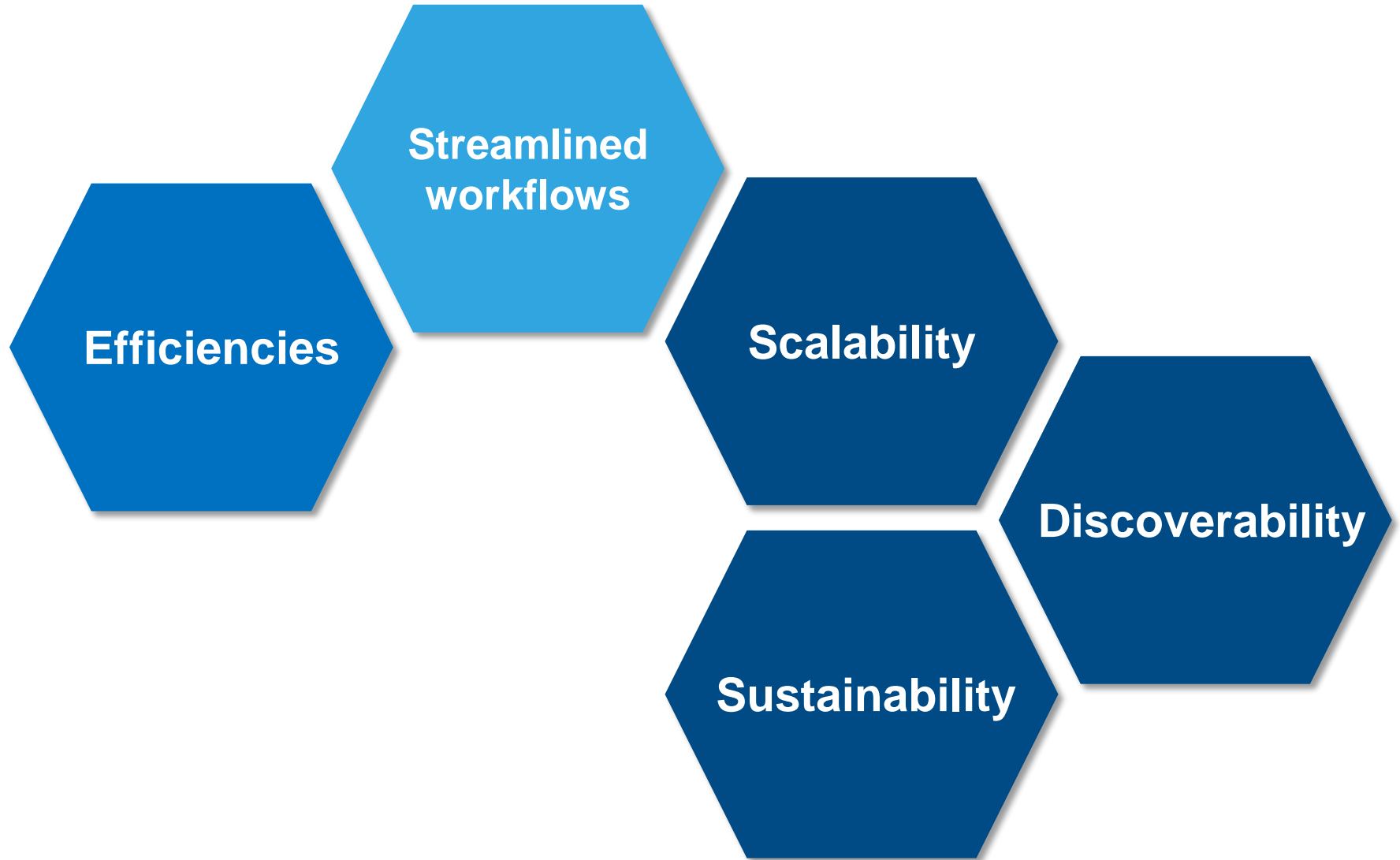
How did the library get involved?

- Provided training and support to editors

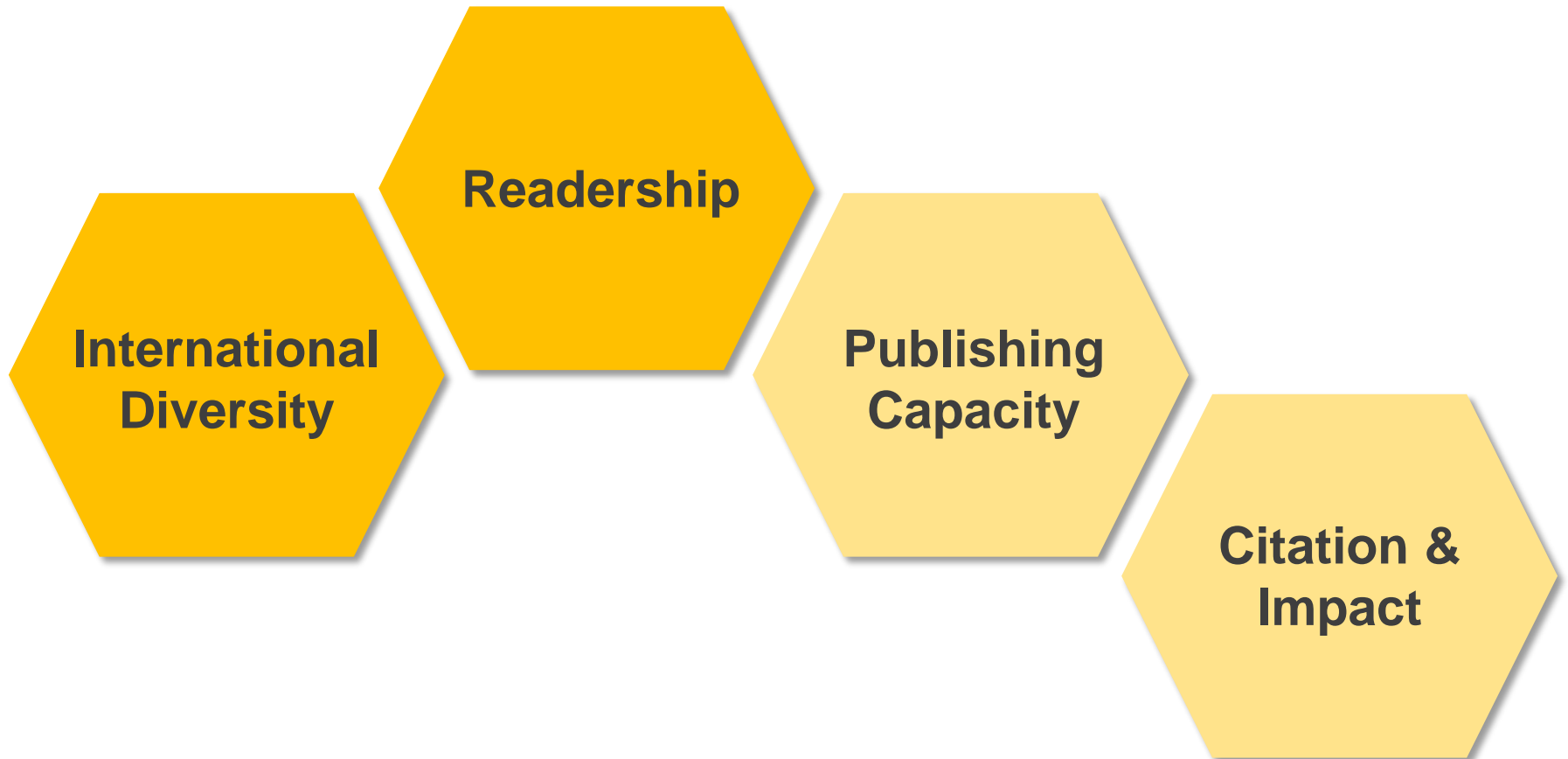
Transition: Print to In-house Online



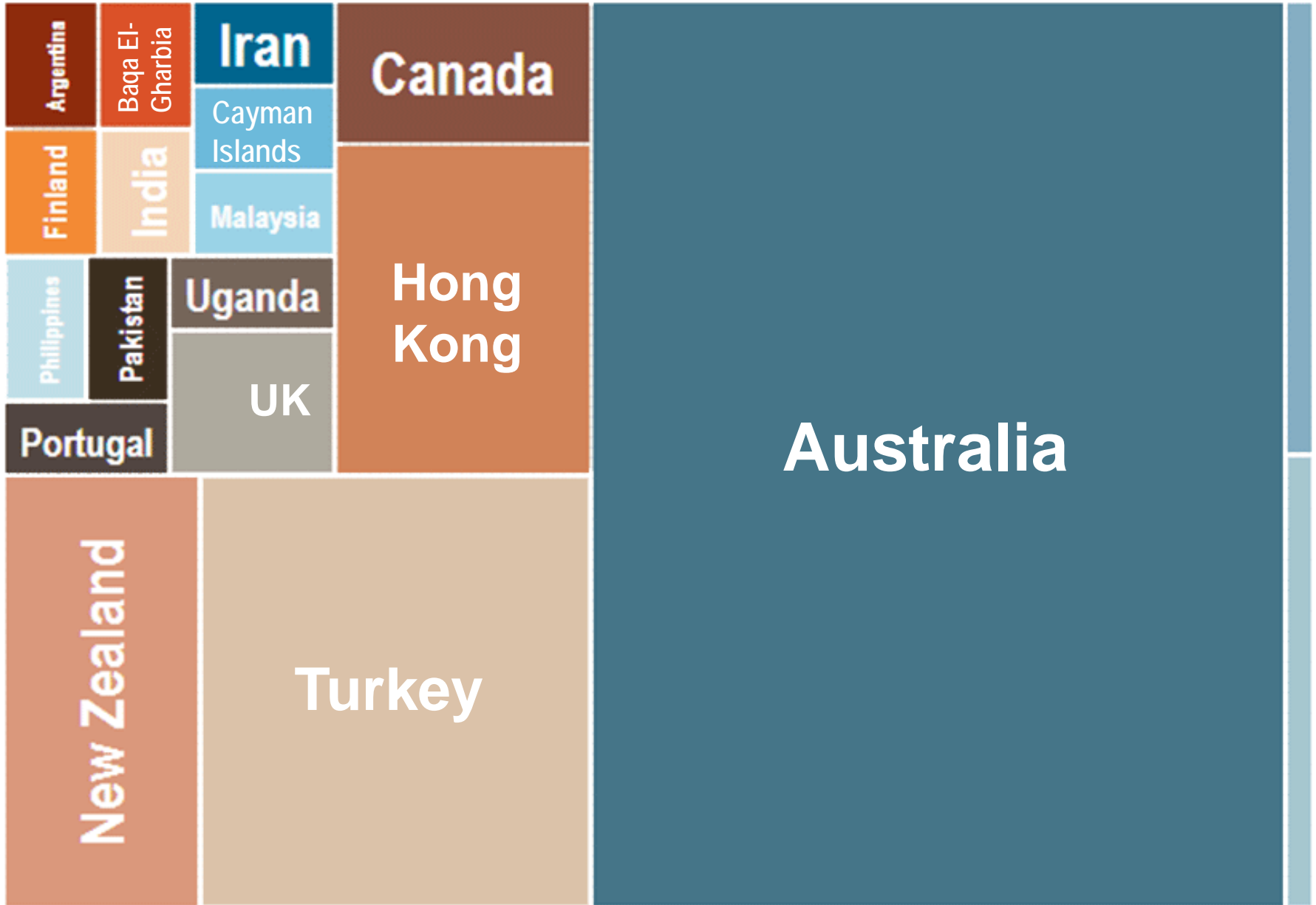
Transition: In-house Online to Research Online



Advantages of Open Access Publishing

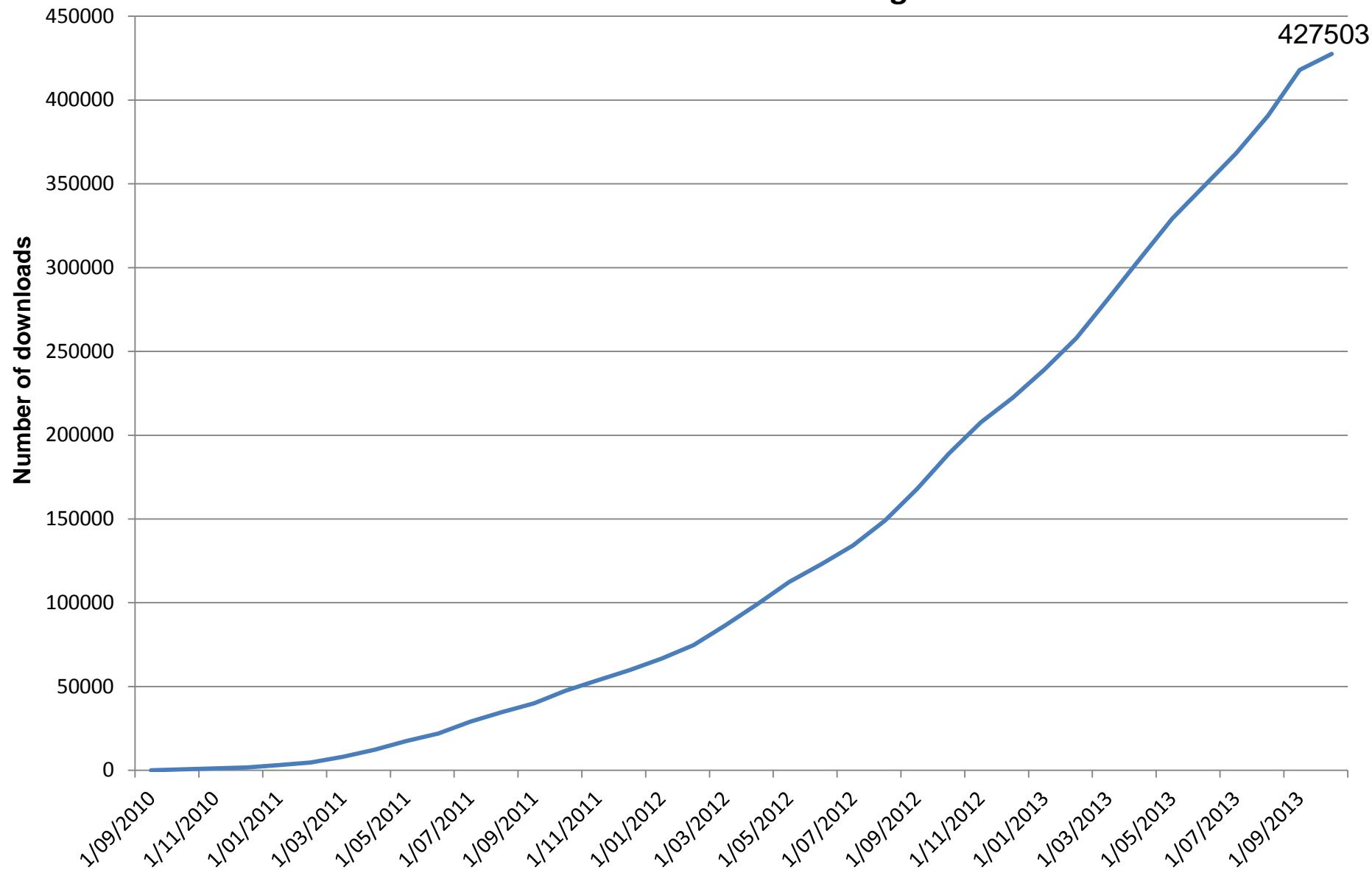


International Diversity of Authors

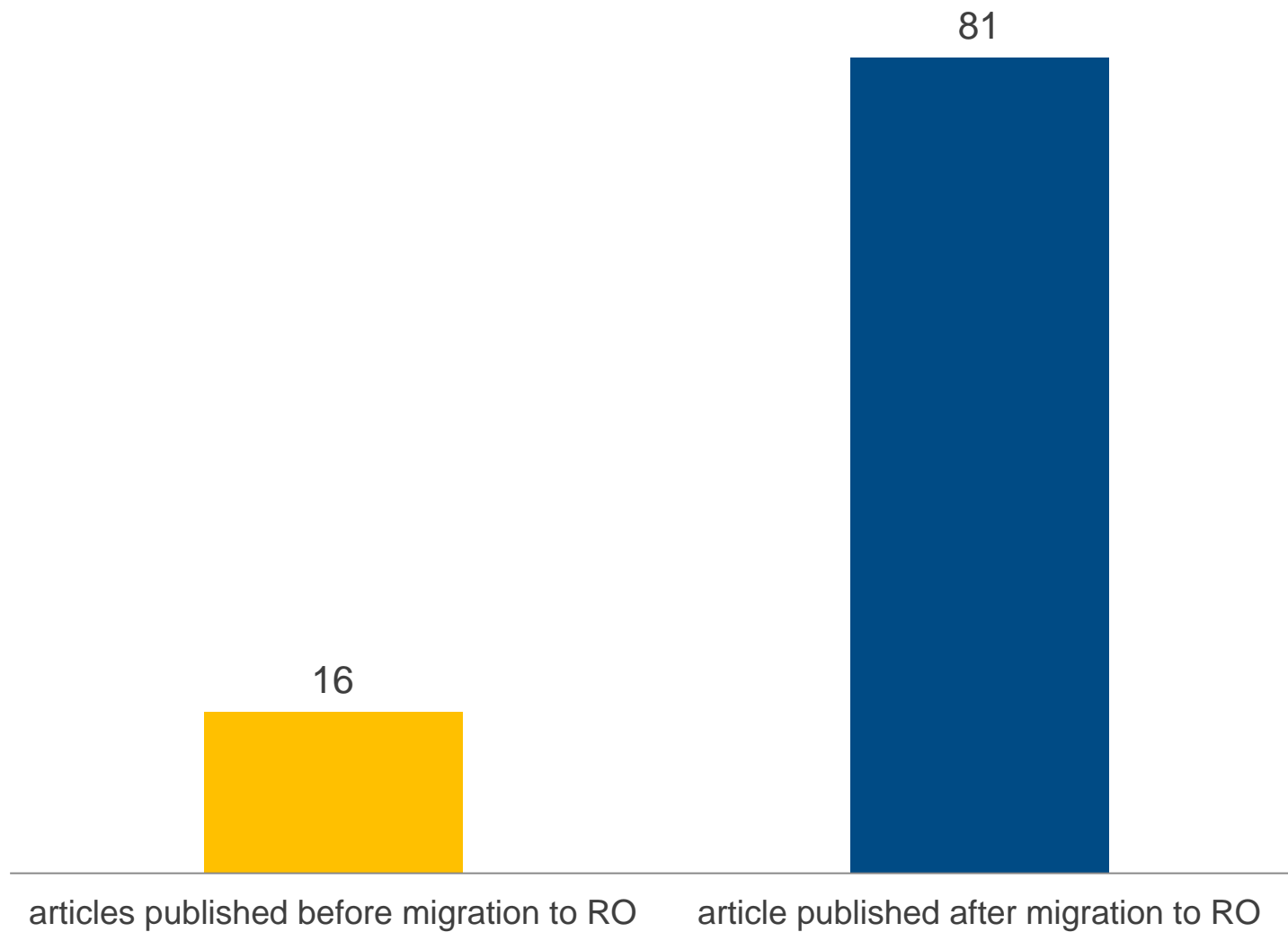


Total Downloads

Accumulative downloads for AJTE since migration to RO

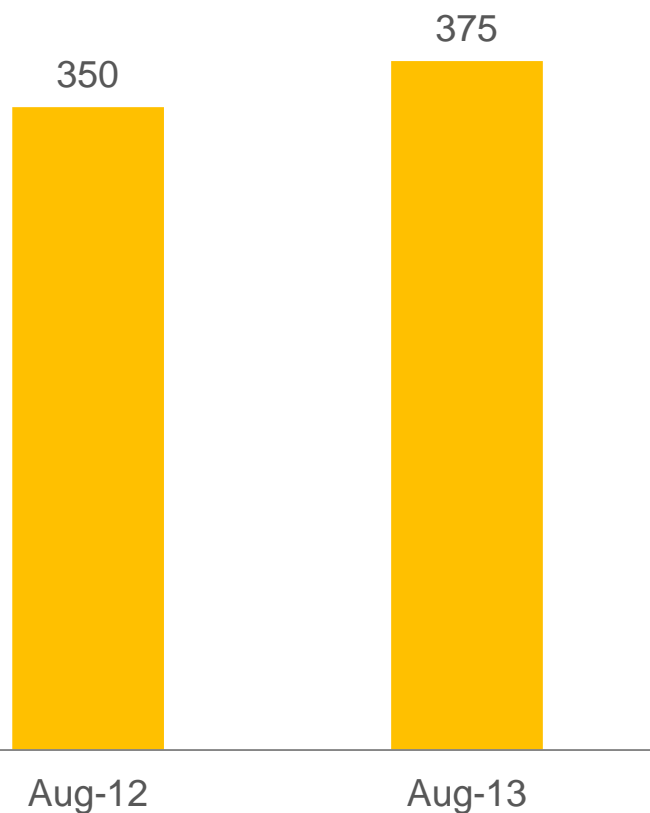


Average number of articles published per year

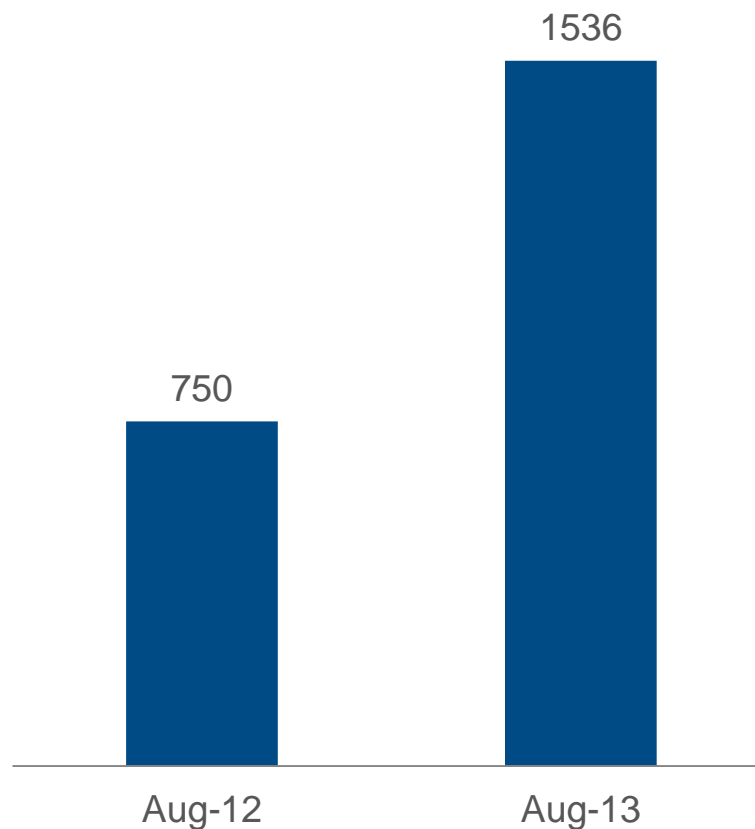


Comparison of Publish or Perish citation data collected in 2012 and 2013 for AJTE over 10 year window 2002 - 2012

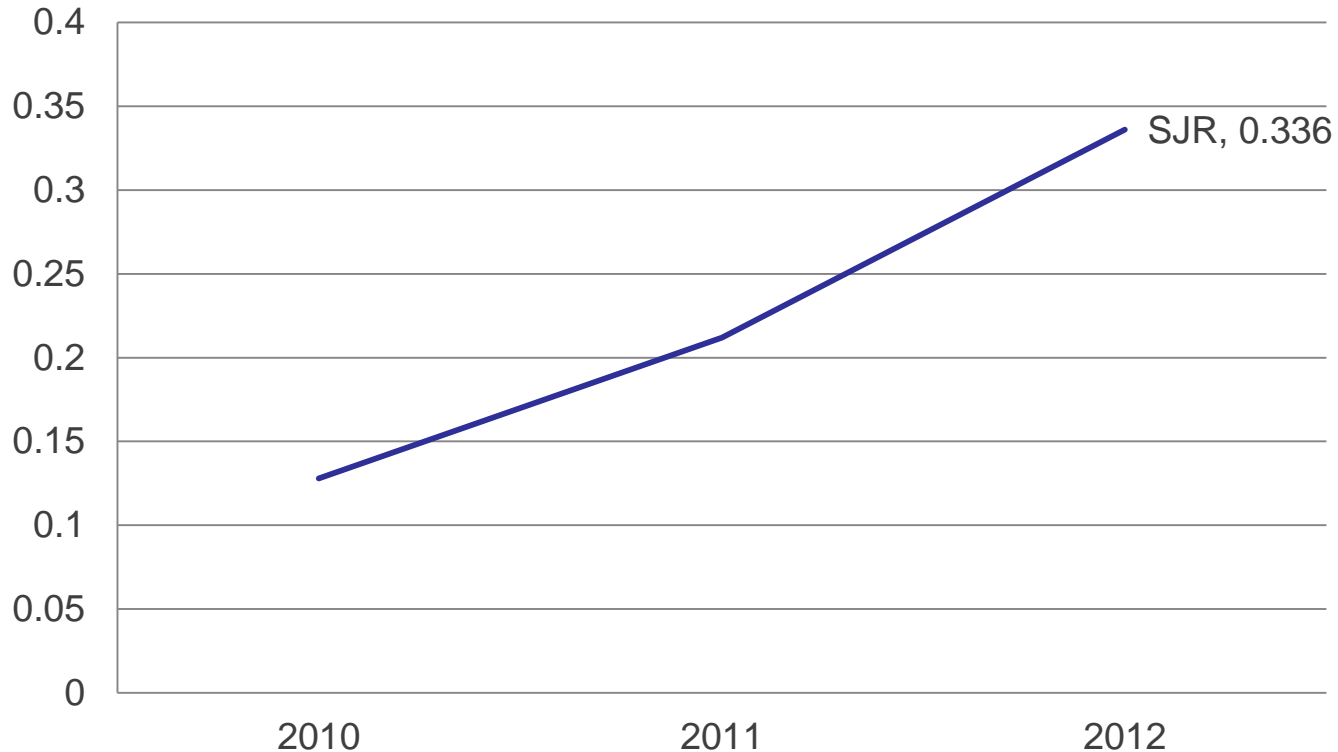
Total papers 2002-2012
