Book Review

Mullins, A. (2005). Parenting for Character. Sydney: Finch Publishing. 176 pages. \$24.95

This book is probably worthwhile reading for pre-service, graduate and experienced teachers. Written in an easy-to-read manner, it is useful for teachers to be aware of the most recent advice being given to parents regarding raising children.

Andrew Mullins advice aims at assisting parents to raise socially responsible, thinking young people who respect both themselves and others. Teachers who are faced with challenging behaviour from an increasing number of students should find Mullins' comments relevant to the development of their own classroom and student management practices. Furthermore, the book provides information helpful when discussing student behaviour with parents.
